Catholic Heart Workcamp Pre-Trip Meeting 1: 2020

Opening Prayer:

In the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit. Amen

Start with Intros (4-8 min):

Have everyone introduce themselves & leader should give a brief intro about CHWC either by Showing a short video clip (Videos can be found on our website CHWC PROMO) and/or telling your personal story of why you love CHWC and why you are bringing a group to camp this summer.

Then ask the following of you audience: (5-10 min)

Who has been to Workcamp before? (have them raise hands - then choose one or two to answer "What makes you want to come back?" (It might be easier to try and pick a teen or two before the meeting to prepare them on what you will be asking) Ask another teen who has been to camp to talk specifically about their work project from last year and their overall experience.

*If it's your first time attending CHWC, consider taking a few minutes to think about why you signed up for camp (consider having them write their answers down and/or have a few people share what their reason are).

Intro Camp Schedule: (8-10min)

Give a brief overview: Something similar to this:

We will depart _____ and arrive at CHWC on Sunday around 12 noon. CHWC will have a team of about 10 people there who will greet us and have been preparing for our arrival. Once we get in our rooms and unpack, we will gather with the rest of those attending camp.

CHWC team, will do some introductions, prayer, training and then finally they divide all of us into work groups. At CHWC they divide up our group so that we work with teens and adults from across the country. You will also find out who you will serve and what kind of projects you will be doing during this week. Then we will close with Mass.

Each day from is very similar Monday-Thursday: Breakfast, Morning Mass, Program, Work Groups serving at their sites till about 3:30pm, Groups return to the school and then have showers, free time, Dinner and evening program.

On Friday we will have our Free Day after morning Mass. (This could be an opportunity to find out what your teens want to do for free day or to tell them what you are thinking about doing for Free Day).

Answer any questions that came up, but don't go into too many details. You will have 2 more meetings to get into more details. If there is time you can briefly talk and review the packing sheet (But remember to save some of that for the next meeting)

The theme for this summer is "I AM"
